### **CURRENT ACTIVITIES**

Electrical, plumbing, HVAC were roughed in in several areas. Insulation and sheetrock began in area C, while painting started in Building E and will continue from the 2nd floor down to the first floor. Once painting is complete, the ceilings will begin.

# **CURRENT ACTIVITIES**

This month was the push towards the end to complete the new building. The new parking lot, basketball court and utility yard were all paved with asphalt. The siding components arrived and that portion neared completion. The playground was beginning to be installed. Inside the building, case work continued. Flooring and floor finishes were underway. All of the resilient carpet, polished concrete, and epoxy flooring was completed, and the installers worked to finish the marmoleum flooring. All of the lighting is now on, and the low voltage equipment was being tested out. Tackable wall surfaces were being installed. All of the furniture was onsite and waiting for the rooms to be finished to set them in place. The temporary modular building for the administrative staff was delivered.
